# The origin of MISP

---

- Project started at **home** 'in a garage'.
- Adopted at **work**.
- **NATO** jumped on the project.
- Became **open source**.
- **Others joined** and grew popular.

# Others

---

- MISP Group W = 134 users
- MISP Group X = 39 orgs and 213 users
- MISP Group Y = 35 orgs (EU + CA) and 142 users
- MISP Group Z = 184 orgs and 433 users
  - sectors: 30% industrial 20% financial et 50% other.

---

- **Information Security and Intelligence Sharing Research Institute**
- **Non-profit** founded in 2015 in Luxembourg
- **Board** not from one organization
- **Mission Statement:**

*The main goal of IS2RI is to promote, ensure and secure the development of free and open source software in the area of information, network and system security. IS2RI strongly believes that secure infrastructures need to be built upon open source security tools where their authors and developers are in an innovative and safe environment.*
